COVID - 19

The self isolation period continues to be 5 days. A pupil who has tested positive will need to take an LFT test on day 5 and day 6. If both of these tests are negative, your child can return to school on day 6. They will not need to isolate for the full day on day 6. If any of these tests are positive they will continue to isolate until they have two negative results 24 hours apart.

I just wanted to remind parents that if your child has any symptoms of COVID-19 they are to remain off school and get a PCR test as soon as possible. They can only return to school if the result is negative. Do not use an LFD test if your child is symptomatic.

SCHOOL SITE

Please note that breakfast club starts at 8.20am and the doors for school open at 8.50am. We have noticed a number of children on school site well before the start of the day. Children are not to be on site until five minutes before the start of the day - 8.45am - or if attending breakfast club 8.15am.


