



Depart from school at 6 a.m. and travel to Dover to take the 12 p.m. P&O ferry to Calais. The coach company used is Peakes Coaches based in Pontypool. We will arrive at Calais, France at approximately 1.30 p.m. and begin our journey through Northern France to the Kyriad Hotel in Disney. We will stop en route for a comfort stop. We will arrive early evening at the Hotel Kyriad and enjoy an evening meal at the Hotel.

Kyriad Hotel, Disneyland Paris.





Set in a beautifully landscaped area, the Kyriad hotel is in the section Val de France of the Disneyland Resort Paris. The unique architecture of this hotel and numerous smaller gardens are to be found adding the atmosphere of farmhouses.

This hotel is about 2km from the Disney entrance gates and is a 10minute shuttle bus ride from the gates, which depart about every 8 minutes.

The hotel contains a restaurant, which serves a fabulous continental buffet style breakfast, which is included into the price. There is also a children's menu for evening meals.

The hotel also has a Disney shop and free shuttle bus to the Disney entrance gates, a children's corner and video games area.



After a continental breakfast at the hotel, we will be driven to the capital city of Paris. Before entering Paris, we will stop at a hypermarket for the children to experience shopping in France, each group will be allocated an amount of money and they along with their teacher will select appropriate items in the hypermarket for their group's picnic lunch, keeping within their budget and ensuring they choose a balanced picnic meal.

After a short city tour by coach, we will enjoy our picnic lunch alongside the River Seine. After lunch, we will board the river cruise for a one hour guided trip down the River Seine to see sights such as the Bastille, Notre Dame Cathedral and many more places of interest. After our cruise, we then visit the Eiffel Tower and experience the amazing views of Paris.







Late afternoon, we will journey back to our hotel to get changed ready for our evening meal.

Evening meal will be in the hotel followed by a visit to Disney Village to shop in the Disney shops.

After a continental breakfast and some leisure time at the hotel, we depart for home via Calais for our ferry crossing stopping along the way for refreshments. After arriving at Dover we will clear immigration and continue our journey back to Senghenydd to arrive home mid evening.

Requirements for trip

- Collective Passport (organised by school)
- EHIC card (these will be collected the week before trip and kept by Mrs Davies for the duration of the trip)
- Night clothes and toiletries
- Trainers or suitable shoes for walking
- Clothes suitable for the trip
- If you would like your child to take photographs, disposable cameras are inexpensive and appropriate for the trip however all staff will take photographs and make these available to parents after the trip
- Small bag for child to carry around during the day to hold drinks, camera etc
- A packed lunch will be needed for the journey to France on Monday.

I will ensure each child has a luggage tag to bring home with all details of the trip, prior to the date, to be attached to their luggage. Each child will also be given a 'credit card' type card to carry around in their bag, with details of all adults mobile phone numbers and hotel information.

What is not needed

- Please don't allow your child to bring expensive video games, toys or mobile phones.
- All adults will have mobile phones with them at all times, if contact needs to be made with parents.

Health certificate will need to be completed and given into Mrs Davies prior to the trip. All medication required for trip will need to be recorded e.g. hayfever tablets, travel sickness tablets, asthma pump. All medication apart from asthma pumps will be kept and administered by Mrs Davies.

The remaining money to be paid will need to be paid by the end of March, you are welcome to pay in instalments up until this date.

There is not a maximum amount of spending money to give your child, however this amount needs to be reasonable. Each child will be grouped for the duration of the trip with a designated teacher who will be responsible for taking care of your child's purse / wallet and ensuring that they are responsible when spending money.

We will ensure all parents are contacted via the text messaging service and school facebook account throughout the trip to inform them of safe arrival, activities the children have done and secure time of arrival on return to Senghenydd.
