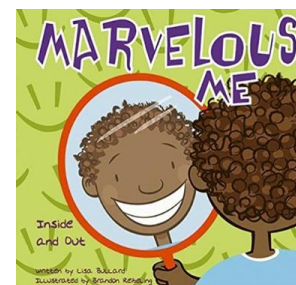
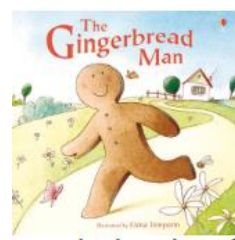




BOOKS THIS TERM



LANGAUGE, LITERACY AND COMMUNICATION

- Pupils will complete a range of oracy, reading and writing activities covering the following genres in school and at home:
- Story writing - Retelling the story 'The Gingerbread Man'.
- Instructional writing - Creating a recipe for a Gingerbread Man.
- Poetry - Autumn countdown poem.
- Welsh - Children will follow the Fflic a Fflac scheme (uned 1 and 2).
- Creating an e-safety poster using Book Creator.
- Christmas product - Writing instructions.
- Pupils will apply their literacy skills through enhanced provision all term.
- Pupils will continue using Reading Eggs in school and at home.
- Digital activities provided through 'Seesaw'.

MATHS AND NUMERACY

- Pupils will engage in many practical activities using various resources to develop numeracy skills in school and at home.
- Pupils will develop skills in the following areas:
 - Number - Counting, ordering, one more, one less, addition, subtraction.
- Problem-solving - Children will solve simple problems in groups using the Badger Maths scheme and White Rose.
- Geometry - Shapes.
- Addition/subtraction - within 20.
- Pupils will apply their mathematical skills across all areas of learning during enhanced provision activities and through lines of enquiry.
- Pupils will continue using Maths Seeds in school and at home
- Digital activities will be provided through 'Seesaw'.

HUMANITIES

- Children will learn the history of their local community E.g. Senghenydd Mining Disaster.
- Children will look at a map of Senghenydd and make their own maps by including the key places and buildings.
- Past and Present - Our community.
- Seasons and celebrations from around the world.
- Christmas - Children will retell the Christmas story.
- Christmas will look at Christmas around the world.
- European Languages Day.
