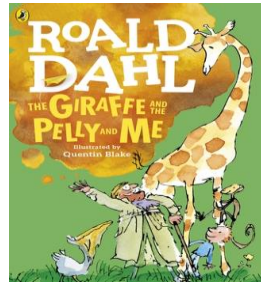
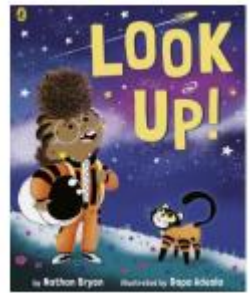

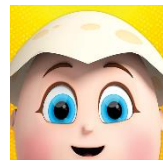

## LANGUAGE, LITERACY AND COMMUNICATION

- Pupils will complete a range of Oracy, Reading and Writing activities related to the text 'Look up!' covering the following genres:
- Newspaper Report- Write about the meteor event
- Hot seating- Drama technique becoming a character
- Inference- Create their own story with the title 'Look Up!'
- Welsh - Children will be introduced to new sentence patterns (eg) Oes...da ti, Pa liw..., Dwi'n hoffi... and Dwi ddim yn hoffi...
- Pupils will continue using Reading Eggs in school and set some homework activities using the programme.
- Sounds Write phonic scheme taught throughout the week.

## MATHS AND NUMERACY

- Pupils will engage with lots of practical activities using a range of resources to develop numeracy skills in school and at home.
- Pupils will develop skills in the following areas:
  - Number** - Place Value , numbers to 100, addition / subtraction within 100, money-amounts / give change, simple multiplication and division.
  - Problem solving** - Children will solve simple problems in groups using the Badger Maths scheme.
  - Times tables** - Pupils will be learning the 2's, 5's and 10;s times table. Use of Times Table Rock Stars to support this in class and at home.
- Pupils will apply their mathematical skills across all areas of learning within the classroom, including outdoors.
- Pupils will continue using Mathletics in school and will complete activities set as homework.

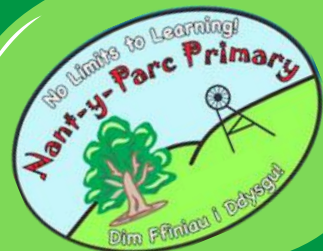
## HUMANITIES

- Pupils will have the opportunity to learn about and explore their local area. They will learn about the history of Senghenydd, places of interest and participate in some fieldwork activities to develop map skills.
- Explore jobs in the local area
- Senghenydd Mining Disaster- Diary writing
- Events and changes in the community – comparing similarities and differences between 'now and then' / 'before and after' the disaster.
- Look at the changes in Senghenydd over time- Sources of information (Primary and Secondary Sources).

## EXPRESSIVE ARTS

### Art

- Colour – Primary and secondary colours
- Pupils explore line, tone and texture
- Picasso Art – self portraits
- Observational drawings of autumnal / winter nature
- Using iPads/ cameras / visualizers /mirrors to support observation drawings

### Music

- Music + Moods – link with colour mixing
- Use 'Bring the Noise' and 'Charanga' educational music programs to enable pupils to learn about music and create their own piece using instruments

### Film and Media

- Introduce pupils to radio room and use of 'Jazzler' to create advertisements

## HEALTH AND WELLBEING

- Children will have regular circle time in class focusing on feelings and friendship.
- Children will continue to do the 'daily check-in'
- Children will explore the impact of social influences

### PE

- Gymnastics – travelling, rolls, jumps – using vaults, balancing.
- Games (Physical Literacy) – Understanding rules in a game, play to learn activity skills, e.g. speed, movement, dodging.
- PE will be every **Friday**. Pupils to attend school in appropriate PE kits
- Pupils will have opportunities to explore ways we can be healthy and confident through our JIGSAW sessions focusing on Dreams & Goals and Healthy Me

## SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

- Pupils will cover a range of activities and investigations in Science linking to the topic 'Sun, Moon and Earth'
- Pupils will research and write facts about the Sun, Moon and Earth
- Pupils will compare and contrast the Moon and Sun
- Pupils will use phrases to describe the Sun, Moon and Earth
- Pupils will describe the movement of the Moon relevant to the Earth
- Pupils will explore the phases of the moon
